THE BOOKING PROBLEM

A forgettable speaker wastes the one day the whole team is together. **This one earns it back.**

A shared language for pressure

Control the controllable · own the good, bad and ugly · choose the next step.

Permission to be honest

Teams start talking about what went wrong, not only what shipped.

Relevant across seniority

Graduates and executives leave with the same three tools, not a motivational hangover.

A moment people repeat

Audible gasps in the room, then a queue of people wanting to talk afterwards.

Control the controllable

Name what cannot be changed, then put the effort where it moves something.

02

Own the good, bad and ugly

Claim the win without false modesty.
Claim the mistake hard enough to stop it repeating.

03

Choose the resilient next step

Let the setback land, then decide the one action that follows it.
